Round-Up of 2020

With the challenges of the Covid19 pandemic, it was really important that Raising Health supported projects to help with patient care and the health and wellbeing of our much-valued and hard-working staff and volunteers.

Here's how we helped

We applied and were awarded almost £300,000 in grants from **NHS Charities Together.** We used this money to support:

- Wobble Rooms for staff, stocking them with fruit and hand creams.
- Boredom buster items for patients.
- A Virtual Health & Wellbeing Festival led by our Health & Wellbeing Team.
- Our Board wanted to thank all staff for going above and beyond in very difficult circumstances, so thank you letters and pin badges were sent to staff.
- Grants to our staff network groups were provided to ensure that our BAME and disabled colleagues were supported throughout the pandemic.
- We have kept money aside from these grants to upgrade our staff rooms so that they are of a more consistent quality across LPT. We have produced a plan with estates colleagues and work will commence from April 2021.

We continued to receive two grants from the **Carlton Hayes Mental Health Charity**. Thank you to all of you who applied for the grants through Raising Health and we saw some amazing projects and ideas to support our patients with mental health conditions.
